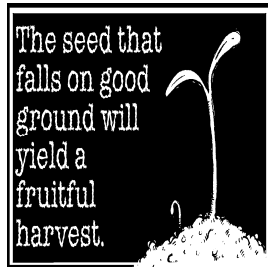

PROJECT UPDATE**

- Tuck pointing of the 1958 and 1966 buildings is nearing completion. The workers continue to remove the existing cracked mortar and replace it with new mortar that will preserve the integrity of the structure for many years to come.
- Demolition of the existing parish kitchen is complete and we are in the process of correcting our drainage problems. The project is still on target to be completed in August.
- New handicap accessible doors and better hardware have been ordered and will be installed in the next few weeks.
- Liturgical banners and vessels for Mass have been ordered and some have been delivered. Hopefully everything will be received soon and will be used for the first time during our Jubilee Mass on Sunday, October 5th.
- The electrical infrastructure sub-committee is still determining the scope of electrical needs regarding technology and other classroom needs.
- The architect for the parish life center has been selected and is in the process of preparing a design and estimated costs.

Pledges and contributions are still coming in and we sincerely thank all those who have submitted pledges and/or made contributions in support of these projects. We encourage all parish members who have not yet pledged or contributed to prayerfully consider helping us in these endeavors.
