Camp is becoming simpler for parents this year! You will be able to write all checks to the school which means only one check per week. We are hoping that this will be a smooth transition, as Mary Brooks will remain the Camp Director and your contact person for any questions or concerns.

This is the ultimate "have it your way" camp. We are offering you the choice of registering for one 3-hour camp or two 3-hour camps whichever weeks work for you. If you sign up for two 3-hour camps in a week, you must also sign up for lunch care. The morning camps run from 9:00 – 12:00 and the afternoon camps run from 1:00 – 4:00. We are also offering before and after care 7:00 – 9:00 and 4:00 – 6:00. You sign up and pay for the times that you need. **You will need to pack a lunch and snack for your child** and send a water bottle and sunscreen.
