



## By far our biggest expense is staff salaries and benefits.




MARION COUNTY TEACHER SALARIES



Despite a new increased salary scale being implemented by the Archdiocese, some of our teachers still lag FAR behind the salaries of their counterparts in public schools. Our teachers' dedication and passion are to the mission of St. Matthew and Catholic education, not to the monetary reward. Yet there is no denying our starting teachers make approximately \$8,000 less PER YEAR, and our veteran teachers make \$20,000-\$30,000 less PER YEAR!!!


