Indiana Choice Scholarship (Voucher) Program (Grades 1 -8)

This program provides scholarships to eligible Indiana students to offset tuition costs at participating schools, including St. Matthew Catholic School. Students must satisfy **both** household income requirements (listed above) and student eligibility criteria (listed below) to qualify.

Student must qualify by **one** of the following eligibility tracks:

- Student has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Service Plan (SP)
- Student is required to attend an “F-rated” public school based on residence (N/A for 2022-2023)
- Student has received a Choice Scholarship in any previous school year
- Student has received a scholarship from an approved SGO in any previous school
- Student is placed in foster care and supporting documentation from a DCS case worker is provided
- Student attended a public school, including a charter school, in Indiana for the full previous school year and is entering first grade or higher
- Student has a sibling who received either a Choice Scholarship or a scholarship award of at least \$500 from an approved SGO in any previous school year

An application along with a copy of your 2021 Federal Income Tax return is required. This information must be submitted each year to continue the Indiana Choice Scholarship Program.

Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGO)

For families that meet the income guidelines, but not the eligibility track for the Indiana School Choice (Voucher) Program, tuition assistance may be available through SGO Grants. Private donations make SGO grants possible through the Institute for Quality Education. Tuition assistance funds are limited, so it is important that you complete and submit your application and Federal Income Tax return as soon as possible. Receipt of a SGO award is a pathway to a future Indiana School Choice Scholarship.
