## WE ARE LEARNING:

**<u>RELIGION-</u>** Students needs to know the 12 Apostles on Friday, April 26. We will be learning about Penance and confessing our sins to God.

<u>MATH-</u> 4<sup>th</sup> graders will be working on an in-class math project. Students will select a topic of interest, create a survey and frequency table, then use the data to create different types of graphs. Due to I-Learn testing, we will not have a DMR quiz on Friday. Students will still have a time test. IXL lessons DD3 and DD4 are due Monday.

<u>SCIENCE</u>- We will conclude Life Science Ch. 2: *How do Animals Grow and Change?* Soon, students will begin research projects on an insect/animal of their choice in lieu of a test over this chapter. <u>LANGUAGE ARTS-</u> We are having a lot of fun with figurative language! So far, we've learned about similes, metaphors, hyperboles, and personification. Next week, we'll focus on alliteration, idioms, and onomatopoeia. Again, there will be NO spelling activities or test next week due to ILEARN testing. We'll resume normal spelling once we conclude testing.

INDIANA HISTORY- This week we focused on how the economy works, wants vs needs, choices, and supply & demand. Students brainstormed ideas for starting a business of their own and the planning involved.
